The Environment Policies aim to educate and raise awareness among our students about environmental issues, while also encouraging them to actively participate in green initiatives through various curricular and co-curricular activities.

### Environmental Policies

- The college actively promotes tree planting to increase green spaces and aims to plant thousands of trees.
- Regular awareness programs are conducted, and tree saplings are distributed as part of these initiatives.
- Students and faculties are encouraged to use the college bus for their commute and are advised to use designated pedestrian pathways on campus for safety.
- Transport is restricted beyond certain points within the campus to minimize vehicular impact.
- The administration takes proactive measures to reduce plastic usage by students, faculty, administrative staff, and vendors on campus, striving to achieve a plastic-free environment.
- The college adheres to stringent environmental management policies and practices, following government guidelines and setting environmental performance targets based on a thorough understanding of current environmental needs.

### Energy Conservation

- The college promotes energy conservation through the use of alternative energy systems, such as solar power, and by replacing CFL bulbs with LED bulbs.
- Bicycles and battery-operated vehicles are encouraged to reduce carbon emissions and support green energy initiatives on campus.
- Adequate ventilation is provided in all classrooms to utilize natural sunlight and fresh air, thereby minimizing the need for artificial lighting and fans.
- In addition, the college emphasizes turning off lights, fans, and air conditioning in classrooms, laboratories, conference halls, and seminar rooms when they are not in use.
